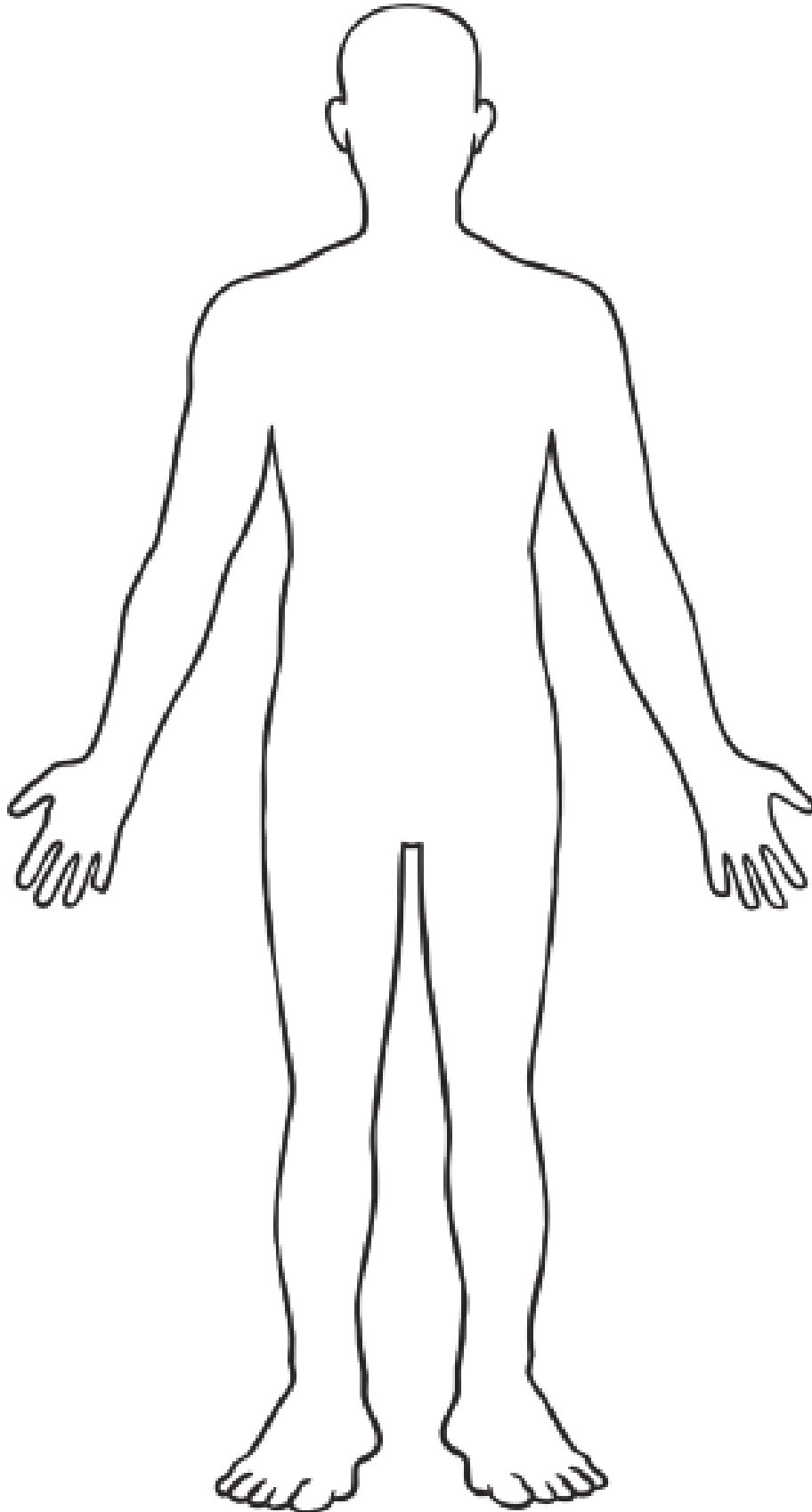


# Activity 1 - Where Are Our Bones?

Don't worry if you are unable to print these sheets. Instead, look carefully at the different bones and work out how they fit together.

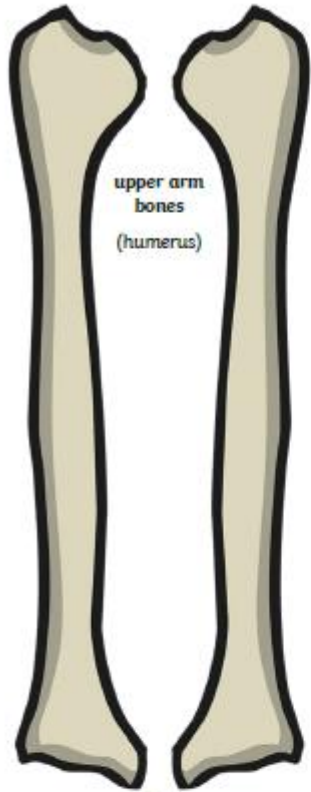
