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| <p>Maths (Mathletics for all will be set on Tuesday)</p> | <p>This week Mrs Steele and Mrs Turner have continued to set work using The White Rose resources, however, we are working on different weeks to the latest set out on the website so please look closely at the details below. Please follow the link https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-6/ to access your work for this week.</p> <p>Mrs Steele's group: Please complete the work labelled 'Summer term week 4 wc 11th May' which is focussing on multiplying and dividing fractions. You will be able to access the videos on the White Rose website as usual, however, you will now find the worksheets and answers on the school's website. This is because, beginning with this week's resources, The White Rose is no longer making all of its resources accessible to the general public and so you will need to find them via the school's website.</p> <p>Mrs Turner's set: Please complete the work labelled 'Summer term week 3 wc 4th May' which is focussing on fractions. You will be able to continue to access the videos, worksheets and answers on The White Rose website as these resources are still free for the public to access.</p> <p>The White Rose Maths Team will also be online each weekday between 10.00 and 11.00am – great opportunities for your child to show and share their work, questions and ideas every day.</p> <p>Please note- Friday's lesson (challenge questions) contains questions which range from KS1 to KS3. Challenges 1 and 2 are aimed at ages 5-7; challenges 3-6 for ages 7-11 and challenges 7-10 for ages 11-15.</p> |
| | <p>Mrs Skehan/ Ms Gamiet's maths set: This week we would like you to begin some work on ratio. Open each of the documents throughout the week (day 1 on Monday etc.). Answers are also attached so that you can check your work. We would also like you to work on your arithmetic skills by completing the 'Arithmetic Daily Challenge' which is also attached.</p> <p>Don't forget! You should also be practicing your timestables. With each task, remember to read the text carefully (we suggest more than once) and look for evidence in the text for each of your answers.
