

Dear Parent/Carer,

As we move in the final term of Year 4 and we are all becoming more settled in our Home Learning Tasks, we thought it may be useful to give an example timetable of the recommended daily tasks for the Year 4 children to complete. Please use this timetable as a guide, it may be helpful to see the weekly tasks set out in a timetable for clarity and to help you plan your child's week.

Along with this, we have also added a teacher recorded explanation to some of the tasks this week. This should support your child in accessing the tasks independently. On some occasions, adult guidance may still be necessary for certain tasks.

Please find the details below of the learning tasks for your child to complete during the week beginning **Monday 29th June**:

Reading Comprehension – First News is a child friendly newspaper that reports on all current affairs from around the world along with some quirky and interesting news articles too.

Please complete the First News Reading Comprehensions, puzzles and picture quizzes (please feel free to complete these in an exercise book or on a sheet of paper if you are unable to print them)

The First News Newspaper for this week has also been added to the 'Extra Resources file' for you to read. This week, you will also find another fun First News debate to participate in, if you choose.



Spellings – On the Year Group information section of the school website you will find your weekly spellings for **Group A** and their associated activities to carry out over the week. You will also find the recommended daily spelling activity on the timetable document.

Watch your spelling PowerPoint and have a go at the task on the PowerPoint and write 5 high quality sentences using 5 of your words.

Tuesday (Task 1):

Complete the look, cover, check, write sheet and complete 5 sentences using your other 5 spellings.

Wednesday (Task 3):

Complete your handwriting sheet with your spellings.

Thursday (Task 4):

You will find a different activity to practise your spellings as well as a word search.

Friday (Task 5):

Ask an adult or an older sibling to test you on them on Friday. Keep a log of your scores.

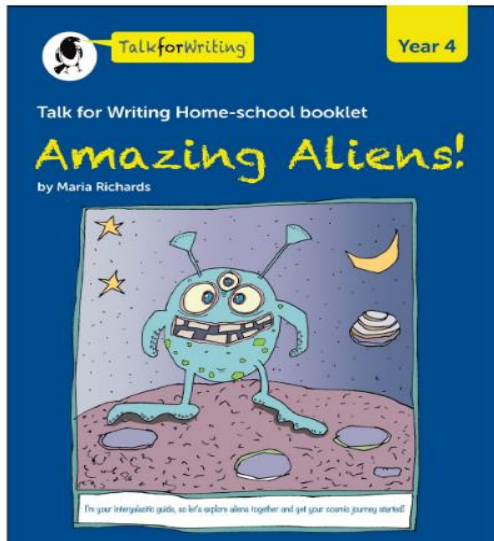


SPAG: For your SPAG this week we are going to look at using the past tense and verb families.

Don't forget that there will be work set on Mathletics as well.

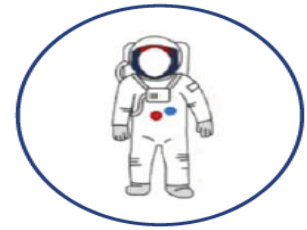
Computing:
