<u>Science related activity</u>	<p>Please see the Science PowerPoint all about identifying flowers.</p> <p>At the end of the PowerPoint are some activities to have a go at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wild plant hunt – choice of two - Match wild flowers to descriptions - Match names of flowers to pictures - Press your own flowers
<u>Reading-</u>	<p>Continue reading every day.</p> <p>Use the R.E.A.D document for comprehension questions throughout reading.</p> <p>Make a list of all the books you have read independently or with a grown up.</p> <p>Choose a challenge from the Reading Challenge Grid. How many can you complete?</p>
<u>Spellings</u>	<p>Spelling rule – Common exception words.</p> <p>Follow the PowerPoint to address the spelling rule this week. Please choose your child's spelling group. If you are unsure of what group they are in, please see the previous spelling lists in your home learning packs.</p> <p>Complete the look, cover, write sheet as normal. Can you write three different sentences which include some of your spelling words from this week?</p> <p>Please encourage and support your child to review Year 1 common exception words and become familiar with the Year 2 common exception words. A word mat has been provided in the extra resources file.</p>
<u>Handwriting</u>	<p>In the extra resources file there is a handwriting sheet based on your weekly spellings.</p>
<u>RWI</u>	<p>Children on the Read Write Inc Phonics and reading scheme can be supported in the following ways.</p> <p>There are Phonics lessons on Facebook and YouTube for children to watch at home.</p> <p>Three short Speed Sound lessons with one of the RWI team. These will be released every day and will be available for 24 hours.</p>

	<p>A weekly story time and poetry time for the children to listen to and read along with.</p> <p>As well as an abundance of resources on the Oxford Owl for Home from Oxford University Press, including phonics resources, ebooks and ebooks that are matched to RWI.</p> <p>Please see the phonics document for more information and links to Facebook, YouTube and Oxford Owl.</p>
