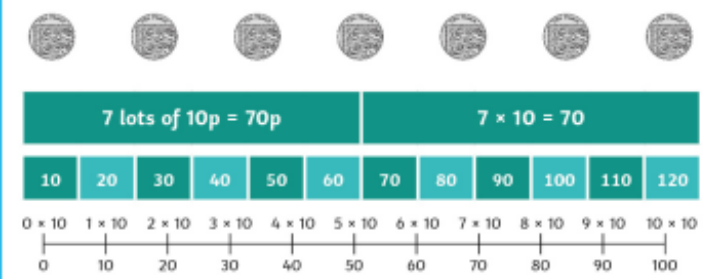
The 2 Times Table

The 10 Times Table



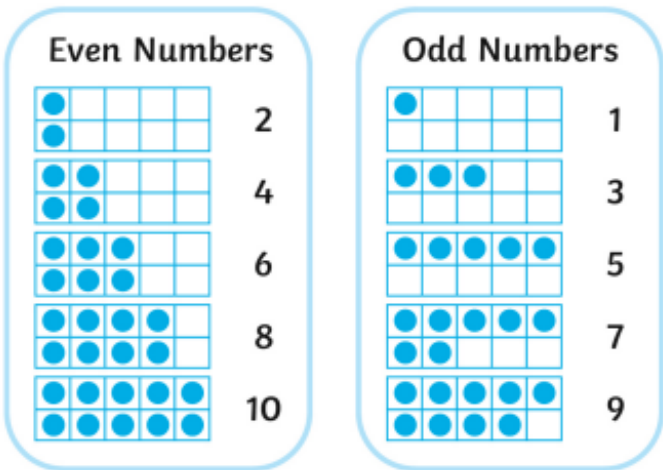
Divide by 2

There are 10 sandwiches altogether.
There are 5 lunch boxes.
There are 2 sandwiches in each lunch box.



$10 \div 5 = 2$

Odd and Even Numbers



Divide by 5

There are 30 grapes altogether.
There are 5 bowls.
There are 6 grapes in each bowl.



$30 \div 5 = 6$

Doubling and Halving



Double 6 is 12

Half of 12 is 6

Divide by 10

There are 50 pencils altogether.
There are 10 pots.
There are 5 pencils in each pot.



$50 \div 10 = 5$
