Adverbs

An **adverb** tells us more about **how** something is done.

Adverb = **adds** to a **verb**

The boy is shouting.

The boy is shouting **loudly**.

verb **adverb**



The lightning flashes.

The lightning flashes **brightly**.

verb **adverb**



Many **adverbs** are made like this:

adjective	+	ly	adverb
loud	+	ly	loudly
bright	+	ly	brightly
